Review Land Trust

- Using land trust money (\$86,000) to be used on improving literacy/reading at NW
- Hired two Reading teachers
- Land Trust funds will be revisited in Winter for plans for next year

- Focus is on school culture and climate, including Second Steps, Techniques for Tough Times, Academic Game Plan, Latinos in Action, Intramural Sports, and After School Programs
- EEP will be reviewed at the next SCC
